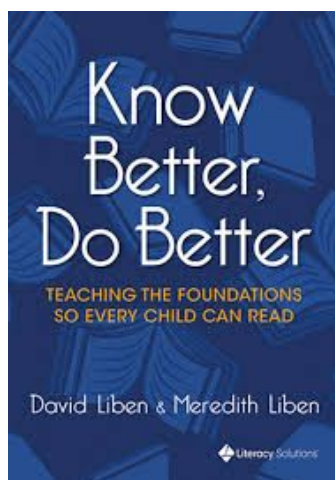

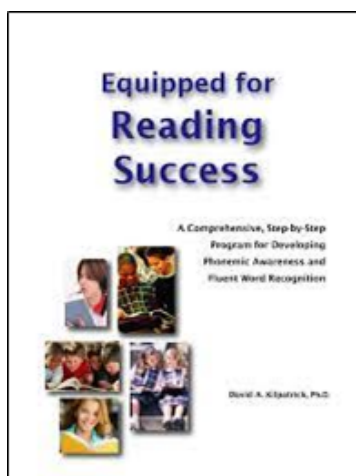

reading skills developed.

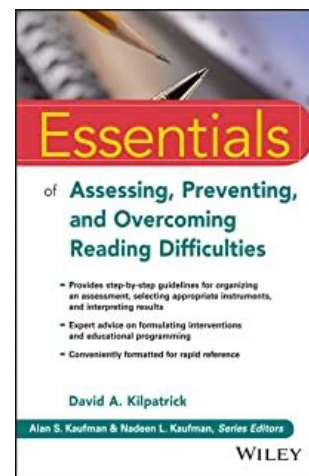
There are up to 2 hours of
